Stabilize Your Housing

Apply now to stabilize your housing. For the first time in many years, <u>you can apply for Section 8</u>.

Section 8 helps families rent from private landlords. Families pay no more than 40% of their income on rent; Section 8 pays the rest. This makes good housing much more affordable.

Friday, May 28, is the deadline for the Section 8 lottery. Please click here to see if you qualify and start your application.

Save on Internet Access

Get help paying for internet access at home. To support families during the pandemic, the Federal Communications Commission is offering \$50 per month to cover broadband expenses. You also can get \$100 off the cost of a new computer.

Find Vaccines for Teens (and Adults, Too)

The city keeps opening more places to get COVID vaccinations. You can <u>schedule</u> <u>vaccinations ahead of time</u>, but you don't even need to an appointment. Just click here to see a list of walk-up sites.
