Last weekend, Phyllicia accepted an offer to work near her home. We wished her success in her new school, and then our hiring committee got to work.

After interviewing multiple candidates from other schools, the committee turned to someone we know and trust. I'm glad to welcome **Aishah Abdullah-Yishrael**, one more time, to CPE1.

Aishah taught at CPE1 for more than a decade. She is still in graduate school. She will use her CPE1 classroom for her required field work and will take classes at night.
